OFFICIAL RULES

How to Enter Contest

- Participants must be a member of Muckleshoot Rewards and at least 21 years of age to participate. Membership is free and can be obtained at Muckleshoot Rewards Center from 8am to 12am or at Muckleshoot Box Office on Saturday, October 29, 2022, by 9pm.
 - Must present a Valid Identification card upon enrollment.

Contest Judging

- Participants will be issued a contestant number upon registration at Muckleshoot Rewards Box Office on Saturday, October 29, 2022, and at approximately 9:00pm, contestants will present costume in a *preliminary round* on stage before a panel of judges. Each contestant's costume will be rated from a score ranking of 1 (*lowest score*) through 10 (*highest score*). Judges scores will be tallied and determine the top ten (10) contestants. Highest possible score, fifty (50).
- Top ten (10) contestants must return to the stage for a *final round* where a second (2nd) panel of judges will utilize the same criteria to determine the top five (5) overall best costumes. In the event of a tie, an appointed tie-breaker judge will be allowed to determine the final winner(s).

Contest Rules

- Participants MUST enter doors of Muckleshoot Events Center.
 - Additional entrances including "Door 2 and/or 4" will restrict entry of any participant in a Halloween costume through the entirety of this event.
- Participants will be required to remove face masks/coverings upon entry and/or during registration. Upon clearance of Muckleshoot Casino Security personnel, participants must remain within the Muckleshoot Events Center for the duration of the contest.
- Wearing of a face mask/covering is only permitted in the reception hall of the Muckleshoot Events Center or while inside of the Muckleshoot Events Center.
 - Participants who are observed wearing a face mask/covering on the gaming floor will be instructed to return to the Muckleshoot Events Center. Participants who do not comply will be dismissed from the contest, forfeiting all awards within, and will be required to leave the premises.
- Registration is free and will be held from 6pm to 9pm on Saturday, October 29, 2022, at Muckleshoot Casino Box Office.
 - Participants must present a valid identification card, Muckleshoot Rewards card, and complete the contestant entry form.
 - Event excludes guests who currently are with a "barred" status.
- Registration is limited to one (1) per entry. No group entries.
- Registered participants will be issued a contestant number and must keep prominently displayed on their persons through the entirety of the event. Contestants are responsible for the number they are issued which will not be reprinted nor replaced if loss or stolen.

Contestants whose costume and/or conduct fails to meet any requirement(s) outlined below will result in immediate disqualification from the contest, forfeiting all prizes within.

- Halloween costumes and/or props must conform to the Muckleshoot Casino's behavior, safety, and policies. Items **NOT** permitted include but not limited to
 - Weapon(s) of any kind (*simulated or real*), use of pyrotechnics: fire, flash powder, explosives, smoke bombs or fireworks.
 - Costumes with electric power.

- Costumes that are considered lewd, obscene, or offensive at the sole discretion of Muckleshoot Casino management will not be allowed.
- Full or partial nudity. Costumes may not be excessively revealing in nature or be constructed of “see through” type material around any explicit areas on the individual. Contestant violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, unless contestant modifies costume to satisfactory adhere to this rule, at discretion of contest management.
- Live animals, *of any kind* is restricted to service animals only.
- Face make-up must be conservative, minimal and face recognizable always.
- Costumes must move through entrance/exit doorways of Muckleshoot Casino. Size restrictions are as follows; *32 inches wide by 7 feet tall*.
- Muckleshoot Casino will not be held liable for any type of damage that occurs to any costume/accessory arising out of or relating to any contestant's participation in this contest, and any affected contestant assumes all liability thereof.

Contest Prizes

- Top five (5) contest winners will be awarded cash prizes.
 First Place: \$10,000
 Second Place: \$5,000
 Third Place: \$2,500
 Fourth Place: \$1,500
 Fifth Place: \$500

General Rules

1. All Participants must show their Muckleshoot Rewards card and valid photo identification to be verified.
2. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe (Tribe), any other sponsor and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use, or enjoyment of the prize(s), or damages or losses related to the tournament.
3. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend or terminate the tournament or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
4. By entering or participating in the tournament, participants grant the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likeness or voice for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
5. Prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes - unless expressly stated in the contest rules - are not permitted, provided that, in the event the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties.
6. Winners will be required to present valid photo identification acceptable to the Tribe, social security number, and complete an IRS Form W-9 and a winner release form before a prize will be awarded. Failure to provide required identification and complete required IRS Form W-9 and a winner release may result in forfeiture of prizes.
7. Participants acknowledge that prizes may be subject to tax withholding requirements under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes and fees not included in the prize. The Tribe will report winnings in excess of \$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS and such winners will receive an IRS Form 1099.
8. For tournaments that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino Resort or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
9. For promotions that require physical participation: All game pieces will be shuffled thoroughly by a team member of Muckleshoot Casino Resort. Then, randomly arranged on the game board by a different team member of Muckleshoot Casino Resort, ensuring content of any game piece is not visible to anyone from any angle.

10. Participants are responsible for hearing tournament announcements and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to tournament announcements. If the tournament involves a drawing, in case of public address system failure the drawing may continue and in such event the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.
11. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, or coupons, computer malfunctions or other incidents resulting in loss of entries.
12. The Tribe is not responsible for inability to enter a tournament or a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
13. Employees of Muckleshoot Casino Resort and Bingo are not eligible to participate in tournaments or drawings.
14. Entries are not transferrable.
15. Violation of tournament rules may result in disqualification.
16. All game/rule inquiries will be initially handled by the Marketing Department. Any Participant dissatisfied with a Marketing Department decision/ruling in a promotion may, within thirty (30) days of the disputed decision/ruling, submit their complaint in the form of a written petition for relief to the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission. The Marketing Department's decision/ruling on any matter within the promotion will be final unless a timely written petition is filed with the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission.
17. Awarded Free Play must be played at least once through any valid video gaming device. All Free Play awards will expire 30 days after activation.
