Battle of the Snowmen
January 4, 11, 18, & 25, 2023
Official Rules

How to get an entry:

1. Guest must be a member of Muckleshoot Rewards and at least 21 years of age to participate.
2. Participants may obtain entries by.
 - a. Receive one (1) free entry daily by inserting your Muckleshoot Rewards card in any Video Gaming Device (VGD) from 6am on January 1, 2023, to 6:59pm on January 25, 2023.
 - b. Receive one (1) bonus entry(s) for every 2,500 base points earned on your Muckleshoot Rewards card while playing any of your favorite Video Gaming Device (VGD) and/or open a rating on selected days; Wednesdays, January 4, 11, 18, & 25, 2022 from 6am – 6:59pm.
 - c. Double entries (2 entries for every 2,500 base point earned) will be awarded on Tuesdays, January 3, 10, 17, & 24, 2023 from 6am – 6:59pm.
 - i. Entries are deposited into a participant's account as they are accumulated.
(*Point Multipliers do not count toward earned entries.*)
 - d. Qualified participants will receive an offer to claim bonus entries on select days, depending on their Monthly Rewards segment for each drawing as described under Active High or Active Low in the Monthly Rewards Rules.
 - i. Entry(s)/Bonus entry(s) requires the inserting of a participant's Muckleshoot Rewards card into a valid Video Gaming Device (VGD).

How to be selected:

1. Drawing(s) will be held on January 4, 11, 18, & 25, 2023.
 - a. Electronic Quick Draw (EQD) drawing for two (2) winners will occur at 5pm and 7pm.
 - i. A total of four (4) winners per drawing date.
 - ii. Total of sixteen (16) winners for the entirety of the promotion.
2. The first name and Muckleshoot Rewards card number of the winning participants will be announced via casino overhead.
 - a. Participant(s) must be present to win and will have five (5) minutes to come to the designated Promotion Area to be verified. If a participant *does not* claim their winning entry within five (5) minutes, the winning entry will be forfeited, and another participant will be drawn.
3. Participants may win only one time per promotion date.

How to play/win:

1. Verified participant(s) will proceed to opposite sides of the gameboard.
 - a. Game board will consist of six (6) columns identified as A, B, C, D, E, & F and nine (9) rows identified as, 1-9.
 - b. Each participant will receive a total of four (4) game piece(s) resembling a snowman.
2. Participant(s) will instruct a Promotions Specialist where to place their game piece(s) on the gameboard.

- a. Game piece can only be placed vertically.
- b. EX: Mary asked Janey to place her snowmen on the following coordinates.
 - i. A1, A2, A3, & A4.
 - ii. B5, B6, B7, & B8
 - iii. C3, C4, C5, & C6
 - iv. D5, D6, D7, & D8

- c. Each snowman game piece will take up four (4) spaces vertically.
3. The participant that was verified first will instruct a promotion specialist on their selections.
 - a. Participant will have four (4) picks in attempt to hit the opponent's, Snowmen.
4. If part of the opponent's snowman is hit, a Specialist will place a snowball game piece on the snowman and say "HIT".
 - a. After the four (4) picks have been used, it will be their opponent's turn to select four spots.
 - b. Whenever any of the snowmen has been fully hit, the next time around the contestant will lose a pick.
 - c. For example, if 1 of Cristian's 4 snowmen have been fully hit, he will lose one pick in the next round. (He will only call out 3 picks instead of 4.)
5. First person to destroy ALL four (4) of their opponent's snowmen, a Grand prize of \$10,000 will be awarded. Second place will receive a consolation prize of \$2,500.

General Rules:

1. All Participants must show their Muckleshoot Rewards card and valid photo identification to be verified.
2. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe (Tribe), any other sponsor and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use, or enjoyment of the prize(s), or damages or losses related to the tournament.

3. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend or terminate the tournament or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
4. By entering or participating in the tournament, participants grant the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likeness or voice for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
5. Prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes - unless expressly stated in the contest rules - are not permitted, provided that, in the event the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties.
6. Winners will be required to present valid photo identification acceptable to the Tribe, social security number, and complete an IRS Form W-9 and a winner release form before a prize will be awarded. Failure to provide required identification and complete required IRS Form W-9 and a winner release may result in forfeiture of prizes.
7. Participants acknowledge that prizes may be subject to tax withholding requirements under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes and fees not included in the prize. The Tribe will report winnings in excess of \$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS and such winners will receive an IRS Form 1099.
8. For tournaments that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino Resort or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
9. For promotions that require physical participation: All game pieces will be shuffled thoroughly by a team member of Muckleshoot Casino Resort. Then, randomly arranged on the game board by a different team member of Muckleshoot Casino Resort, ensuring content of any game piece is not visible to anyone from any angle.
10. Participants are responsible for hearing tournament announcements and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to tournament announcements. If the tournament involves a drawing, in case of public address system failure the drawing may continue and in such event the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.
11. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, or coupons, computer malfunctions or other incidents resulting in loss of entries.
12. The Tribe is not responsible for inability to enter a tournament or a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
13. Employees of Muckleshoot Casino Resort and Bingo are not eligible to participate in tournaments or drawings.
14. Entries are not transferrable.
15. Violation of tournament rules may result in disqualification.
16. All game/rule inquiries will be initially handled by the Marketing Department. Any Participant dissatisfied with a Marketing Department decision/ruling in a promotion may, within thirty (30) days of the disputed decision/ruling, submit their complaint in the form of a written petition for relief to the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission. The Marketing Department's decision/ruling on any matter within the promotion will be final unless a timely written petition is filed with the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission.
17. Awarded Free Play must be played at least once through any valid video gaming device. All Free Play awards will expire 30 days after activation.
